**Presentation Categories**

We invite you to share your experience and expertise with your colleagues at this year's conference; consider presenting on your best practices, case studies, techniques and solutions. The IACA welcomes proposals from introductory through advanced levels on a variety of topics including (but not limited to):

- Crime analysis case studies (75 minutes max.) – these are not restricted to tactical analysis; they can include special projects, redistricting, workload allocations or anything similar.
- Investigative or analytical techniques
- Statistics
- Analyzing specialty datasets such as cell site data, unstructured text, etc.
- Hands-on computer training (75 minutes max.) – this includes applications such as MS Excel, MS Access, crime mapping, Crystal Reports, SQL, or similar computer-based programs). If your presentation will be a computer lab, please specify this in your proposal.

**Selection Criteria**

Workshops are evaluated based on the abstract submitted and the speaker's background and work experience. We have many attendees from Canada, Mexico, Europe, South and Central America, the Caribbean, and the far East regularly attending this conference, and that number is growing each year. We strongly encourage members from countries outside the United States to submit presentation proposals.
